SCRAP TIRE COLLECTION

Two ways for Summit County Residents to recycle old tires!

ONE DAY EVENT: Saturday, April 24, 2021 from **9 am to 11 am** at ReWorks' Household Hazardous Waste Recycling Center (HHWRC) on 1201 Graham Road in Stow.

DURING HHWRC SEASON: Same tire rules apply, but bring your tires when the HHWRC is open. See HHWRC section below for details.

PLEASE NOTE:

- > Summit County residents only (no businesses)
- > \$1.00 fee per tire (CASH ONLY)
- > 10 tire limit per vehicle (passenger car & light truck size)
- > No Household Hazardous Waste is accepted at the April 24th event.



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE RECYCLING CENTER (HHWRC)

ReWorks provides an option for Summit County residents to handle their household hazardous waste.

PLEASE NOTE:

- > Summit County residents only (no businesses)
- > Open **Thursdays** from **2 pm to 7 pm** – **June 3, 2021** through and including **September 30, 2021**
- > No latex paint
